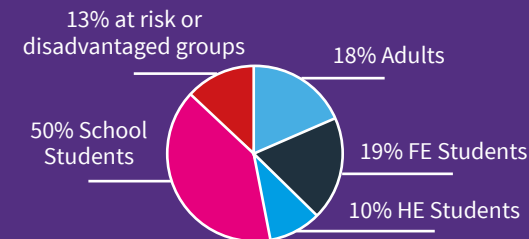

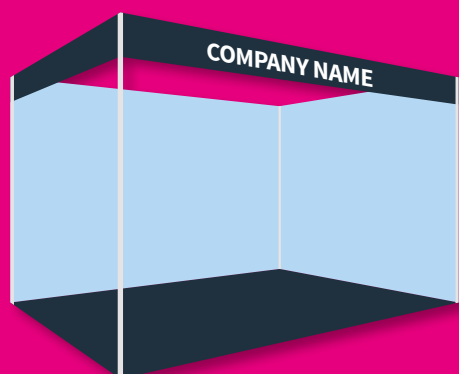


Dedicated Seminar Programme
